Blockchain was originally created to support a cryptocurrency called Bitcoin.

As a currency, bitcoin has been tremendously successful. In only a decade, it's gained widespread adoption. It also has introduced people to the concept of distributed ledgers, which is the fundamental technology behind blockchain. As a freely tradable, independent currency, bitcoin has a number of uses, such as cross-border payments. It's relatively slow, but highly secure. People replace trust in a government, such as the US government or the UK government, that might issue what many people would call a fiat currency or a central bank currency, with this distributed digital currency.
